

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING TECHNIQUES AND LEARNING EXPERIENCES TO IMPLEMENT DURING SCREENING

Effective activities that nurture and encourage advanced responses:

- Are open-ended to promote multiple correct responses at diverse levels of understanding.
- Require high-level thinking.
- Are equitable for children from all demographic groups.
- Relate to grade-level curriculum and may be incorporated into instructional topics or subject areas.
- Are substantive rather than peripheral.
- Encourage integration of skills and learning standards.
- Assess students' depth and complexity of information.
- Activate students' mental engagement, process engagement, and social-emotional connections
- Minimize teacher preparation and paper work
- Only use activities and techniques at which all or at least most students can succeed on a daily basis; we dare not risk frustrating most students to identify a few.
